

# LIVE BY FAITH

"Faith Gives Us a Fresh Start" | Mark 10:46-52 (NIV)

Without faith we cannot please God. We must believe that He exists and that He wants to reward those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6). It's in believing that we receive. Faith is all about believing — believing that Jesus is the Son of God, believing that He is a miracle worker, and believing that He will do what He says He can do. When we place our faith in Jesus, He offers us a fresh start, a new beginning. We see that clearly in the story of Bartimaeus. "Your faith has made you well," Jesus said to Bartimaeus, the blind man. He was determined to make sure Jesus heard him when He was walking past, so Bartimaeus shouted loudly, making a fool of himself. Jesus stopped and asked, "What do you want me to do for you?" When Bartimaeus asked Jesus for his sight, he received it immediately and was healed. Bartimaeus' faith in Jesus changed his whole life, it gave him a fresh start. Our faith in Jesus offers us a fresh start as well if we will just believe. Have you ever wanted a fresh start? When you ask, He will forgive your past, and give you a new beginning. It's Jesus' specialty. He's ready to strengthen and help you. It is never too late to start again. Jesus is just waiting for you to ask!

# **Jewelry Making**

In the Jewelry Making classes we will learn how to make Boho Beads! Making Boho Beads is a delightful and relaxing experience. Every bead created is a beautiful and unique collection of components pulled together in a way to reflect the maker's aesthetic. A variety of small scrap materials can be incorporated into your Boho Bead, including meaningful elements such as a scrap of lace from a wedding dress or bead from your mother's broken necklace. The bead can then be a central focal component assembled into a bracelet, necklace, earrings, purse dangler, key chain fob, bookmark enhancers, ornaments, and more!

There is no fee for this class, but donations will be greatly appreciated for BFUMC's Good Samaritan Fund to help those in need!

<u>Tools needed</u> (Jewelry making kits can be found at Michaels and other retailers. A limited number of tools will be available for participants to share if you do not have your own):

- Round nose pliers
- Small fabric scissors
- Flat nose pliers
- Emery board
- Flush cutter
- Safety glasses

<u>Materials needed to make Boho Beads</u> (materials will be provided, but you may wish to bring your own):

- Paper or plastic straws
- Fabric scraps
- Fabric glue
- 20 gauge jewelry wire
- 26 gauge jewelry wire
- Beads (4-11 mm)
- Seed beads
- Sequins
- Tiny buttons
- Thread, yarn, trim, embroidery floss, ribbon scraps


