"What We Believe About Transforming Grace" | Ephesians 2:1-10 (NLT)

What we believe about God's amazing and transforming grace is at the heart of United Methodism. We are a people of grace – constantly receiving grace that transforms our lives so that we look more and more like Jesus as we grow in our faith. We believe that God's grace reaches out to us even before we know who God is in the form of prevenient grace. We believe that God's grace works in our hearts to reveal our sins, so that we might offer our sins up to God and be forgiven. We believe that God's grace is what reveals Jesus Christ to us and inspires us to accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. The moment we receive Jesus into our hearts we are justified – and this is justifying grace at work. It is still grace but now the grace encourages us to receive Jesus and confess our sins. As we walk with Jesus, our faith grows and sanctifying grace works to make us more and more like Jesus. We love more, forgive more, serve and give more to the work of Christ in this world so that others might experience God's grace for themselves. This week we look at grace at work in John Wesley's conversion and the conversion of the apostle Paul. And we will have the opportunity to receive the grace of God into our hearts and lives once again.
