"Jesus and Nicodemus" | John 3:1-21

In John 3, Jesus' late-night conversation with Nicodemus reveals the profound mystery and necessity of spiritual rebirth. Though Nicodemus was a respected religious leader, he struggled to understand the life-changing truth Jesus offers: "You must be born again." This passage challenges us to move beyond mere religious knowledge and embrace a living relationship with Christ through the Holy Spirit. As we explore Jesus' words about being born of water and the Spirit, and the depth of God's love in John 3:16, we are reminded that salvation is not about what we do, but about what God has done for us in Christ. This encounter invites us to examine our hearts and respond in faith to the transformative power of God's grace.

HOLY WEEK 2025

Holy Week commemorates the seven days leading up to Easter.

- April 13 Palm Sunday Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey, and is greeted with palm branches and shouts of "Messiah." It is a Christian holiday that marks the beginning of Holy Week, the week leading up to Easter. Join us for the waving of palms and Confirmation for 3 of our young people. 9:30 & 11:00 am worship services.
- April 14 Holy Monday Jesus returns to Jerusalem, cleanses the temple, and curses a fig tree.
- April 15 Holy Tuesday Jesus teaches in the temple and debates with religious leaders.
- April 16 Holy Wednesday Judas betrays Jesus to the authorities for 30 pieces of silver. Pastor Frank will be the guest speaker at 12:00 pm. During Holy Week, Winder First UMC is again hosting their annual Lenten Lunch Lift Monday through Friday. There will be a short service with a guest clergy each day, followed by a light lunch. On this Holy Wednesday, Pastor Frank will be the guest speaker at 12:00 pm.
- April 17 Maundy Thursday Commemorates Jesus' Last Supper and washing of the disciples' feet. It's a day of reflection and a call to action to serve others.

- April 18 Good Friday Jesus is sentenced to death, crucified, and dies on the cross. This is a solemn day of mourning and reflection for Christians. 6:30 pm service in the Sanctuary.

 11:00 am Traditional Worship Service


Prayer Stations


