## SUNDAY, APRIL 13, 2025 | PALM SUNDAY

"Jesus and the Crowd" | John 12:12-19 (NLT)

On Palm Sunday, the crowds welcomed Jesus with shouts of "Hosanna," expecting Him to be a conquering king who would overthrow Rome, but within days, their cheers turned to cries of "Crucify Him!" when He did not meet their expectations. Their praise was based on what they wanted from Jesus, not on who He truly was. Like them, we can be tempted to follow Jesus only when He aligns with our desires, but true faith means trusting Him even when His plan looks different from ours. As we enter Holy Week, may we commit to worshiping Jesus not just in moments of joy and celebration, but also in times of challenge and sacrifice, knowing He is the King who came to save us in ways far greater than we could imagine.


